# M. Phil in Management

#### **RULES**

#### Course structure

The M. Phil course is of 1 (one) year's duration. The first semester will comprise of course work followed by exams. There will be a total of 5 papers – 2 compulsory and 3 optional from each area of specialization, i.e. Marketing, Economics and Finance, HR and OB. (Optional areas offered will depend upon students' area of interest and faculty expertise). During the second semester the students will work on their dissertation. Following viva voce, successful candidates will be awarded an M. Phil degree in Management.

M. Phil awardees who qualify may be admitted into the Ph. D Programme in Management.

# Eligibility criteria

Candidates with Master's degree or equivalent in Management, Science & Technology / Engineering with a minimum of 55% marks. Candidates with background in liberal arts / humanities need to have a management qualification.

Reservation – as per Government rules.

### Tuition fee

A tuition fee of Rs. ----- -- per semester will be charged from selected candidates. Other institutional fees are also applicable.
