Sir,

The examination fees of the backlog examinees of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semester of your college, were not deposited in the University. The onus of such non payment of examinations fee has been shifted to a clerical staff namely one Subhankar Banerjee, dealing assistant of the college.

The Director of the Institute vide his letter dated 07.11.2013 addressed to the Controller of Examinations of this University has tried to evade his responsibility in the matter by stating he was totally in the dark about the said incident. The Director being the Head of the Institution cannot evade his responsibility by tendering such a lame excuse as above. It is also not understood as to how the Officer-in-Charge (OIC) of the examinations allowed such irregular activities of allowing the backlog students to sit for the examination without admit cards.

Since the issue involved is very serious in nature, the university has examined the matter critically and in depth and is of the opinion that the Director of the Institute along with the OIC are jointly responsible for such serious act of omission due to negligence for which the students ultimately are the sufferers till date since their results have not been declared.

However on scrutiny of the available papers pertaining to the said examination, it appears that the sanctity of the examination was not disturbed. Keeping in mind that the students were not at fault, the University has decided to declare their results, subject to payment of the backlog examination fees.

The University however has taken serious note of the irresponsible act as above on the part of senior responsible officials of the Institute in the rank of Director and OIC of Examinations. It is indeed surprising how officials of such senior rank can discharge their duties in such irresponsible manner.

The University has thus decided to impose a penalty of Rs. 2 lakhs upon the Institute. Such penalty along with the backlog examination fees are to be paid to the university, forthwith.
