5. Second status report was given by Dr. Debdut Naskar on Infrastructure and Learning Resources. In this regard, it was advised to prepare the master routine with the help of the

software developed by Ms. Anindita Das Bhattacharjee and give presentation of the same through IQAC. Further advice was given by Prof. Paira.

6. Third status report was given by Dr. Debasis Giri on Student Support and Progression. In this regard, he was advised to add placement data, keep detailed documents and arrange Student Council etc. Mr. Joy Samadder was advised to take necessary actions for further alumni work.
7. Fourth status report was given by Dr. Jaya Bandyopadyay on Governance, Leadership and Management. She was advised to complete the report within 13 July, 2021.
